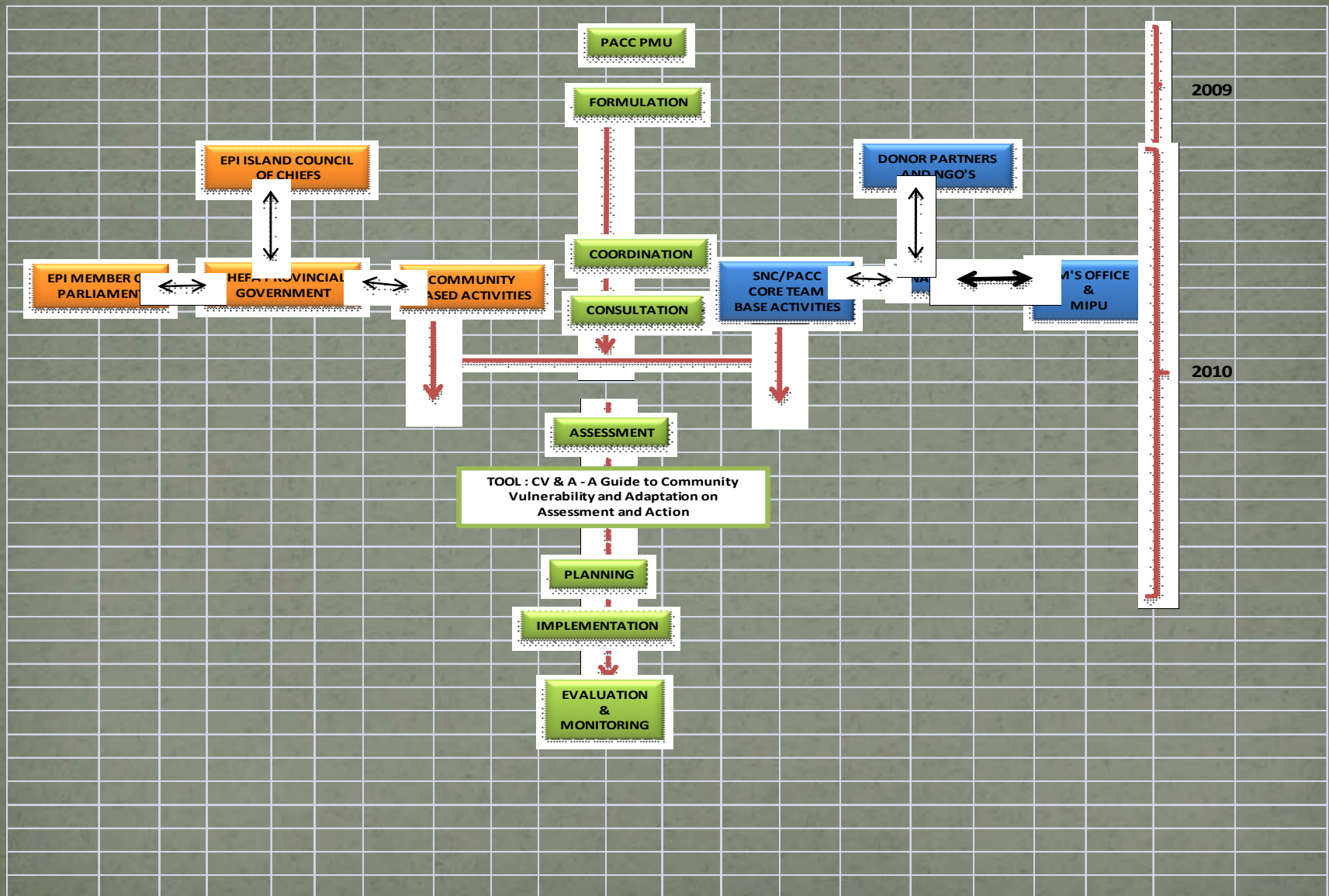

6. Implementation

7. Evaluation & Monitoring

- Erosion of roads

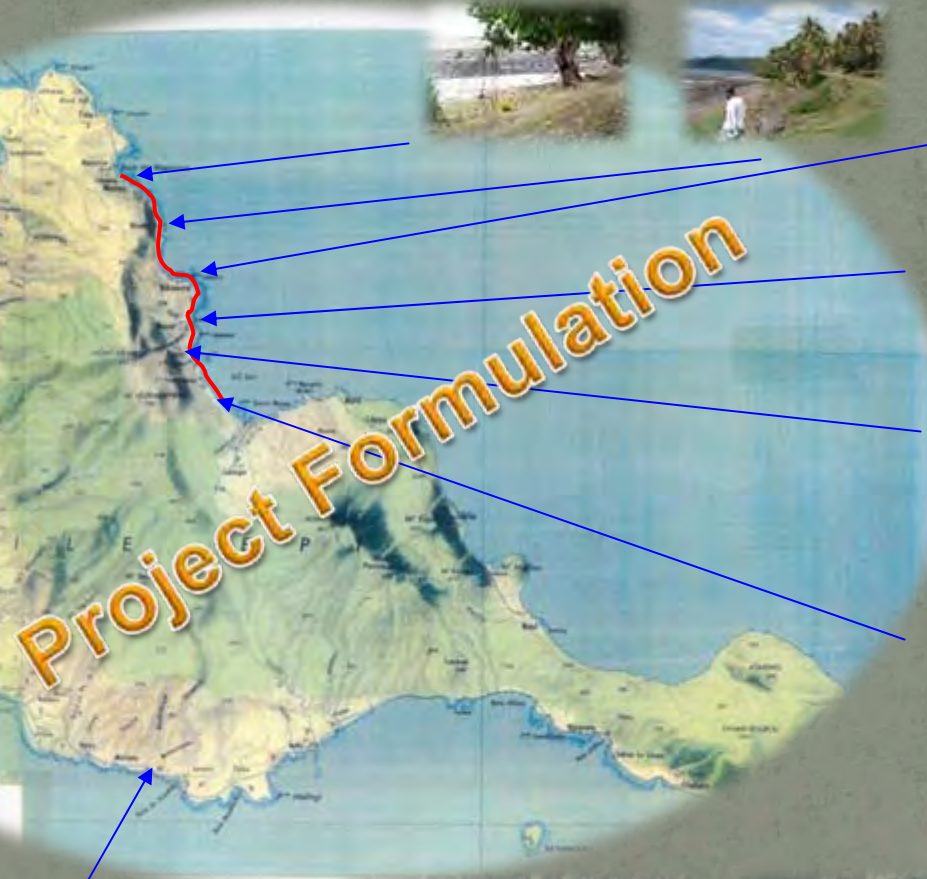
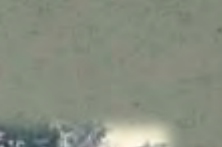
