

# VANUATU TREDs REPORT FOR 2017 - 2018

---

*Summary Report prepared by Juney Ward, SPREP*

## 1. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this report is to provide a summary of tagging and nesting information that has been submitted to SPREP for incorporation into the regional Turtle Research and Monitoring Database System (TREDs).

This report also aims to provide information that can be used to assist turtle conservation work carried out in Vanuatu.

The data held in TREDs is from fieldwork carried out in Vanuatu by the Wan Smolbag's Vanua Tai Turtle Monitors Network and Tranquility Resort. This report provides all data in TREDs received for 2017 - 2018 period.

## 2. TAG INVENTORY

The tag inventory for Vanuatu records all tags received from SPREP and details of damage and distribution of tags. The tag inventory records all flipper tags used for turtle monitoring in Vanuatu.

### 2.1. Tags distributed by SPREP to Vanuatu

Tags distributed to WSB, Environment Unit, Fisheries, Nguna Pele MPA and Tranquility Resort by SPREP now total up to 15,712 (Annex 1).

### 2.2 Tags distributed by other agencies to Vanuatu

There are no records of tags distributed by other agencies for Vanuatu in TREDs.

## 3. SPECIES NUMBERS BY SITE FOR VANUATU

Hawksbill turtle (n=1,550) is the species with the highest record in TREDs for Vanuatu. This is followed by green (n=777), unidentified marine turtle species (n=144), leatherback (n = 17), loggerhead (n=7) and olive ridley turtles (n=5). The details of turtles encountered for this reported period are as follows:

- **2017:** A total of 144 hawksbill turtles and 71 green turtles were reported to be tagged and released from Tranquility Island Resort (134 head starting hawksbill turtles), Malekula Island (51 green turtles, 5 hawksbill), Epi Island (2 green), Futuna Island (2 hawksbill), Vanu Lava Island (3 hawksbill, 16 green) and Aniwa Island (1 green).
- **2018:** A total of 144 hawksbill turtles and 9 green turtles were reported to be tagged and released from Tranquility Island Resort (134 head starting hawksbill turtles), Malekula Island (3 green, 1 hawksbill) and Vanu Lava Island (6 green, 9 hawksbill).

## 4. TAG RECOVERY

### 4.1. Turtles tagged and recovered within Vanuatu (2017 – 2018)

Out of 368 turtles that were tagged for the reported period, 8 turtles were recovered within Vanuatu (Annex 2). Four were initially tagged from Bamboo Bay village on Malekula Island, three nesting green turtles were remigrant nesters with 8 – 13 years of remigration intervals while the one hawksbill turtle was a remigrant nester with 9 years of remigration interval. The other four turtles were tagged from Moso village on Malekula Island, three nesting green turtles and one hawksbill turtles were recovered within nesting seasons.

### 4.2 Turtles tagged outside and recovered within Vanuatu

Three green turtles tag recoveries were from turtles that were reported as nesting and tagged in

South Great Barrier Reef - Australia, French Polynesia and American Samoa. Two additional green turtles were tagged in Australia and French Polynesia, of which the initial tagging record for Australia was unknown, while the green turtle in French Polynesia was released from captivity from Scilly Atoll. The two hawksbill turtle tag recoveries were of turtles that were tagged and released as sub-adults in Australia and Samoa and recovered in Vanuatu (Trevor, 2009) (Table 1). There are no new updates for turtles tagged outside and recovered in Vanuatu for this reporting period (2017 - 2018).

#### **4.3 Turtle tagged in Vanuatu and recaptured outside**

A hawksbill turtle tagged in Vanuatu on Malekula Island in Bamboo Bay village was recovered stranded in Australia at Lake Arrangan beach (Table 2). There are no updates for this reporting period (2017 - 2018).
