

- **Joint National Action Plan (JNAP) on Climate Change Adaptation & Disaster Risk management (completed)**
  - Cabinet submission (Aug 2012)
  - JNAP taskforce (informal) established
  - recruitment
- **Water Act 2012 (completed)**

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Niue Climate Change Policy:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Provides a national policy framework to mitigate the causes of climate change and adapt to its impacts in a coordinated, effective and sustainable manner.</li><li>- It also provides a policy platform upon which Niue can engage with and obtain support from the international community, development partners to address challenges of climate change on Niue.</li></ul></li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ JNAP:<p>The development of the JNAP is Niue's response to national, regional and international processes, agreements and frameworks in strategically addressing risk and vulnerability via a more holistic approach. The Government of Niue has endorsed and integrated, "whole of country, whole of Government" approach to addressing CC and DRM.</p></li></ul>
