Problems/issues	Solutions & Way Forward
Financial delays	No way found
Staff turnover	1 staff resigned and a new one was recruited staff
Management issues -PMU	Involve the Ministry for full support
Technical issues – poor coordination	Work closely with technical expertise in country to address issues
Poor construction equipments available in country	Involve Ministry's support
Multi task on PACC Coordinator, lack of professional expertise	Back stopping assistance sought from SPREP, crop agencies

- Technical support in developing the sectorial mainstreaming guideline to incorporate cc in the sector policies
- Funding for replication
- Funding for continuous of PACCC current activities
